Our doctors will speak with you via phone for your protection as well as ours. Our receptionists will take payment via phone again in an effort to limit contact. The same goes for prescription refills, and prescription food refills.

Until further notice, Dr. Marteney will be available for appointments Mondays, Tuesdays and Wednesdays. Dr. Stanzione will be available for appointments Thursdays, Fridays, and Saturdays.
